## 1. Public Comment

## 2. Review draft of budget for fiscal year Ending August 31, 2023;

Mr. Haskins then presented and reviewed with the Board the FYE 2023 budget and responded to questions from the Board extensive discussion then ensued regarding various line items contained in such budget and the amount of expenses anticipated to be incurred by the District during the FYE August 31, 2023.

Mr. Haskin reviewed the District revenue and certain operational land administrative expenses for the FYE August 2023 certain first (1<sup>st</sup>) day on which applications can be accepted is January 17, 2024, and that the application filing deadline is 5:00 P.M. on Friday, February 16, 2024.

The Board then discuss the necessity of a rate increase.

Board that the District's conversion to a municipal utility district provide the District with the ability to designate defined areas such as the tract owned by Riverway Properties, which will allow reimbursement to Riverway Properties solely bases on the value created in such defined area.
